

Selling your solar home – A Checklist

There are documents that will aid in providing appraisers and future buyers pertinent information regarding your solar home. Most importantly, you must identify your home as a special case requiring an appraiser competent in solar systems. These tools will help ensure that the appraisers and buyers have the proper information regarding the value of your home. It is also recommended to have this information as a packet on counter during showings.

Recommended information to collect:

Solar system plans

- o Physical
- o Electrical maps
- Product warrantees
 - o Panels
 - o Inverter
 - Home energy storage
- Utility records for home energy use
 - Example of bill(s) a fall bill is best as it identifies the credits accrued.
- Copy of a complete Home Energy Rating System (HERS) report, if available.
